APPLIED LINGUISTICS: LANGUAGE TEACHING AND LEARNING

1. Theories of second language acquisition (behaviorism, Universal Grammar approaches, interlanguage theory, Krashen's Monitor Model, Schuman).
2. Error correction (errors and mistakes, types and sources of errors).
3. The language teacher: roles, styles, responsibilities, effective vs. reflective teaching.
4. The language learner: learning styles, motivation, anxiety, aptitude.
5. Different modes of classroom organization (whole-class teaching, individual work, pair and group work),
6. Use of the mother tongue, communication strategies.
7. Teaching different language skills (speaking, listening, writing and reading).
8. Teaching different language subsystems (pronunciation, vocabulary, grammar and pragmatics).
9. Language testing (washback, types of tests, basic dichotomies in language testing: formal-informal, direct-indirect; characteristics of a good test, issues in test construction and administration).
10. Foreign language methodology: tradition (classical, grammar-translation, direct, audiolingual, TPR, CLL, suggestopedia, natural approach) and contemporary trends (CLT, task-based, lexical approach, post-method methodology).
11. Language learning strategies.
